When I checked the mail this past Thursday, I received a package I did not recognize at first. It was a plain brown padded envelope that had been addressed by hand. It was nothing like the packages Stacy and I are used to seeing at our front door from the companies we typically order from online. The return address immediately explained not only the sender but the contents as well: it was the shirt our group would wear in a couple of weeks when we travel to Honduras. Because there will be almost 50 people arriving at the airport in San Pedro Sula on multiple flights from at least six congregations, the matching shirts allow the group leaders to quickly identify those who are in our group.

This year's shirt was designed by a girl named Hannah. I look forward to meeting her and telling her in person how talented I think she is and how I appreciate how she has used her gift for the glory of God's kingdom. I am impressed by artists because they possess in abundance a skill I do not have. Anyone who has seen me draw stick figures on a white board in a Sunday School class is well aware of my artwork limitations.



This shirt represents more than one person using her gifts for kingdom glory. This shirt represents four dozen people who will step out in faith—some for the first time—to go to a developing country to be the hands and feet of Jesus. But this is not the only shirt I write of today. On the back of this bulletin is an example of a new shirt that can be ordered to represent our church family. It too is more than just a shirt. It too was designed by a talented young woman, this one named Hope.

My vision is that when we wear this shirt we will be representing our church family. Our church has come to mean more to me in recent months than words can adequately describe. I'm not sure exactly what we will be doing in the next couple of years as we wear these shirts, but I hope we will discover numerous ways to be the hands and feet of Jesus. I hope all of us will dedicate our heads, hearts, and hands for kingdom glory.
