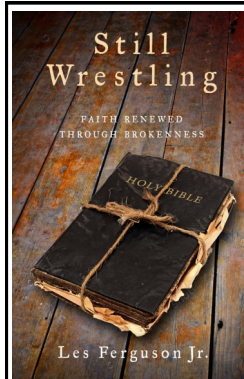
Join us this evening for Summit at 6:00 as we meet our gracious God on a mountain of praise.
